

VOLUNTEER DUTIES:

Take-in Day – Volunteers will review each quilt being entered to ensure eligibility and correct class and prepare for Judging the next day. Volunteers should bring their own lunch and/or snack. Rotation of various “jobs” will help with fatigue. Some “jobs” require standing.

Judging Day – Volunteers will assist with every quilt being judged. Some “jobs” will be to assist and judges. Other jobs are coordinating and organizing quilts. Lunch is provided to volunteers.

Hanging Day - Volunteers will prepare quilts to be hung. Folding, attaching clips, selecting quilts to be hung in what order. Once large quilts are hung, volunteers will team up to select and hang quilts. Long day but very rewarding. No ladders.

Take-Down Day – Just as the name implies, we will take down all quilts. We have one hour to get all the quilts down, remove clips, etc., and fold and organize for returning to Exhibitor. No ladders.

Fair Volunteers – Duties here are to be in the area with the quilts. Walk around and ensure the quilts are not touched, greet the public, answer questions, encourage Viewers’ Choice voting.
